Elementary Music

Come learn about music! We will learn basic music theory together- note names, rhythm notes, chords/intervals, how to read the treble clef, how to read/play rhythm and more! Solfege singing will be a technique taught to read music as well as train the ear to know intervals. The goal is to work with bells to have a mini bell choir. Students will read music and play bells each individually to create a choir sound with bells. This class can be repeated.

Playwriting

In this class, students will dive into the world of playwriting - creating characters and events that will come alive onstage! During the first half of the quarter, we will learn about how plays are formatted, and create our own characters, settings, and plots for our scripts.

In the second half of the quarter, we will bring these scripts to life by having students direct and act in each other's plays. Along the way, students will learn more about the art of playwriting and how it's different from other forms of writing, how to think both like a playwright and a director, and how to create compelling characters that leap off the page.

Homework will include brainstorming ideas for your play, writing your script, giving and receiving constructive and encouraging feedback. Students should come to class with a pencil, a notebook, and a water bottle each week.
