Prices are per student per quarter.

This quarter is a short 8 week quarter so there will be an option to pay everything at once, or split the tuition into multiple payments. All other fees must be paid on the initial payment.

Supply fees are billed up front (the first month) and are non-refundable. Class fees are non-refundable after the first week. Students can sign up for one class or as many as they want. If classes do not have enough interest, they will be closed for this quarter. We have listed the minimum # of students and the maximum # of students on each course. You will be notified in advance if the class has been canceled. See the schedule for times. Students who wish to repeat a class are welcome to do so but must be signed up again.

If you are new to CHC, building and enrollment fees are due up front. Returning Friday only families will need to pay the quarterly enrollment fee per student.

Parents must stay with their elementary aged child at lunch!

All sign ups must be done through YourEDU. If you do not already have an account on YourEDU, you will need to create an account and enter your information as well as your child's information. This is the system we will be using starting next year for all CHC courses.

Next you will select the courses you wish to enroll your child/children in and request enrollment. Once we can confirm we have enough students to offer the class, you will be notified to continue the enrollment process and add payment information into the system. You will be given several payment options. Invoices will not be billed through QuickBooks but through YourEDU and Stripe.

The deadline to sign up for Spring quarter electives is March 31.

Classes are listed in no particular order

Elementary Music - Level 1

Ages: 5-12

Class fee: \$ 65

Supply fee: \$5

Min/Max: 4-12

Come learn about music! We will learn basic music theory together- note names, rhythm notes, chords/intervals, how to read the treble clef, how to read/play rhythm and more! Solfege singing will be a technique taught to read music as well as training the ear to know intervals. The goal is to work with bells and perform a song at Showcase. Students will read music and play bells individually to create a bell choir. This class can and is encouraged to be repeated as we build upon music fundamentals each quarter.

Elementary Music - Level 2

Elementary Music Level 2 is the extension class of Elementary Music. (Each student must have completed at least 1 quarter of Elementary Music or receive approval from Miss Bree) In Music Level 2, we will continue learning basic music theory, solfège and beyond. We will build upon all the musical concepts that we have already learned. We will learn basic recorders in this class too! And possibly continue playing bells as well.

Baking with Emily

This class will explore the basics of baking. We'll dig into some of the science behind baking, how to properly measure ingredients, and some different techniques you commonly find in baking. Students will finish most weeks with a small batch of baked goods to bring home. (We will not be able to accommodate gluten/dairy free baking.) This class will be 2 hours.

Group Voice Lessons

13-17+ (Secondary)

Min/Max: 4-12

Does your student enjoy singing? Do they want to learn more about singing? In this group voice class, students will learn how to sing using proper techniques for breathing, style, diction, intonation, rhythm and more. We will practice singing together as a group with harmony, blending, and learn how to listen to each other as a small choir. The goal for each student is to take home what they are learning and practice it on their own. The hope is for each student to see an increase in vocal range, vocal strength and knowledge of overall singing, individually and with a group. Worship will also be a big part of this class. I want each student to learn and grow as a worship leader. This class can and is encouraged to be repeated, as we build upon our vocal knowledge each quarter. This is two separate classes at different times.

Crocheting & Knitting

Min/Max: 4-15

Come learn the basics of crocheting and knitting! We will spend four weeks in each, learning terminology, basic stitches, and how to read patterns. Students will be able to keep their needles/hooks.

Preschool Music (with parents)

Min/Max: 4-10 students

Come learn about music! We will learn note names and rhythm using fun fruit names. Together we will play instruments and worship with movement/motions. Students will learn how to sing solfege and how to play bells together, which we will share with our families at Showcase.

Parents are REQUIRED to attend with their child.

Theater Smorgasbord

Min/Max: 7-25

Calling all actors – you’re invited to partake of a “smorgasbord” as we sample a variety of theatre arts! Topics explored may include: improv, musical theater dance, scene study, an audition workshop, stage combat, and a comedy intensive exploring humor and comedic timing. Come prepared to be challenged as you dip your toes into many different aspects of theatre, and grow deeper in your acting skills! There will be no showcase for this class.

Beginner ASL

This class is an introduction to the language of American Sign Language (ASL). We will cover the essentials of beginning American Sign Language, learning basic vocabulary, introducing grammar, and deaf culture. As your instructor I learned American Sign Language in my high school and college courses, and I will be utilizing some of the same techniques I learned from in teaching this class. We will be utilizing the book American Sign Language for Beginners by Rochelle Barlow, the book is included in your course fee.

Lego Challenge

This is a repeat class from Autumn quarter.
